**YOUR DEALER.** Selecting a dealership can be just as important as selecting the right RV. If you intend to buy from a dealer, evaluate the dealership as well as the RV's. If you don't buy from a dealer, first check out the dealers who service and stock parts for your rig. In some localities, it might require some extra mileage to find the good dealer who will work with you, but it will be worth it if you must depend heavily on a dealer.

When evaluating a dealership, consider the following points:

1. Is the dealership clean and well-organized?
2. Are the personnel courteous and are the sales-people, service department people and parts department people knowledgeable?
3. Are the service and parts department areas clean, well-organized and efficient?
4. Are the service and parts department hours convenient for you?
5. Ask the dealership for recent customer references and ask the Better Business Bureau for comments.

Try to build a good business relationship with the dealership personnel. Note the word **BUSINESS** here. They are there to make a living just like everyone else. Don't monopolize their time with unnecessary chitchat when there are other customers waiting. When you enter the dealership for parts or service, know as much about the part you need or the problem you are having as you possibly can. Insufficient information can make the job more difficult for the partsman or mechanic and may force you to travel home for the needed information.

Be just as friendly to the dealership personnel as you expect them to be to you. This friendly attitude may result in some special help in the future.
