

Mode	Function Indicators		
Raise	Press once to raise rear of vehicle for increased ground clearance (speed < 20mph)	Raise light flashes	
	Press and hold until raise light remains "on" to raise entire vehicle (speed<10mph)	Raise light "on" continuously	
Lower	Press once to partially lower entire vehicle (speed < 20mph)	Lower light flashes	
	Press and hold until lower light remains "on," to lower entire vehicle to lowest possible height (speed<5 mph)	Lower light on" continuously	
STD Ride (or) Storing Hydraulic Jacks	Press once to return vehicle to "standard ride" height and cancel any active manual mode	Std Ride light flashes while system is returning to standard ride height. Std Ride light "on" steady (only for 15 seconds) when vehicle reaches standard ride height	
Fault	Flashes a 2 or 3 digit error code	Suspension Light

Ensure air suspension is inflated prior to moving vehicle after storing leveling jacks. STD RIDE light will flash while suspension is inflating and will illuminate solid when air suspension is inflated.

hadley  AAISE  ↑  SLS	SLS	Press once to activate the SLS system and initiate the "Level Find Mode"	Level indicator arrows for X (long) and Y (short) axis: Solid Green: vehicle is near level.  Flashing Green: Adjustment possible and within range.  Flashing Amber: Marginal conditions, possible self-level.  Solid Amber: Excessive slope, self-leveling may not be possible.
STD		Press once again to turn "OFF" the SLS system	Level indicator arrows OFF
LOWER RIDE SET  SUSPENSION AIR PRESSURE	SET	Press once to activate the "self-leveling" process (vehicle must be stopped and park brake applied)	Set light flashes as the system levels. Set light ON solid after leveling process is complete
		Press once again to turn "OFF" "Self Leveling"	Set light OFF
	Fault	Flashes when low system pressure	Air Pressure Light
